

### Bus Stops and Parking Spaces Outside Central Beijing

Whereas the original heat map likely obscured the density of these infrastructures, directly plotting the point locations of parking spaces and bus stops offers a more accurate sense of density. Circles on the map highlight points of aggregation of both bus stops and parking spaces in the outer districts of Beijing, suggesting a positive correlation between the two.





## The Reshaped Waters of Chaoyang Park

The colorized base map offers a clearer depiction of the green and water areas within the current Chaoyang Park setting than the original black and white base map. The significant difference in the positions of water bodies within the park raises questions on how the current park was constructed, whether prexisting water bodies were filled up and new bodies dug, and the accuracy of the 1907 map.
